Winemaking:

100% whole cluster fermentation (carbonic maceration) with native yeast in one ton open top fermenters. 100% barrel aged in neutral French Oak. Unfined and unfiltered.

Vineyard Description:

Mizany Vineyard is a 16-acre estate vineyard planted in the famous Cortina Gravel of Dry Creek Valley.. It is farmed organically and is currently going through the certification process. The Mourvèdre comes from a 4-acre block, planted to two different clones.

Tasting Notes:

Cherry cola and mashed raspberry jump out at you on this fruit forward and lively palate. The wine finishes with a touch of cracked black pepper that is characteristic of Mourvèdre. Soft and approachable with bright acidity, this is a food friendly and fun bottle to share with friends and family.
